

Leaf Collection

Scheduled Residential Curbside Leaf Collection is scheduled two (2) times per year: Fall and Spring. Public Works will post notices in the area of collection one (1) week prior to the scheduled collection. Collection dates may also be found by visiting the township webpage at www.waterfordtwp.org or by calling Public Works at 856-767-2359.

Leaves should not be bagged, however, residents who live on Route 30 (White Horse Pike) and do not have access to any a side street or alley may bag the leaves and place them out for collection. These residents are asked to contact Public Works to have them picked up.

In every instance, collection will begin on **Monday** and continue until the entire route is complete for that week. ***Please have leaves on curbside loose at the beginning of your scheduled week.*** Leaves must be free from all other yard debris including sticks, twigs, acorns, and trash, as these things can clog the machine and your leaves will not be picked up. Also, do not park any vehicles in front of or too close to the leaves during your week or they will not be picked up.

If we are ahead of schedule, we may go into heavier areas, but will return on your scheduled week. Thank you for your cooperation.

Leaves and Brush may also be disposed of at the Public Works Convenience Center Saturdays from 9am to 1pm. Residents will be required to show proof of residency before being permitted to enter the PIT.
